Emergency Management - Be Prepared

Winter Car Survival Kit: shovel, sand or kitty litter, traction mats, tow chain, compass, cloth or roll of paper towel, warning light or road flares, extra clothing and footwear, emergency food pack, booster cables, ice scraper and brush, matches and a “survival” candle in a deep can (to warm hands, heat a drink or use as an emergency light), fire extinguisher, extra windshield washer fluid, fuel line antifreeze, road maps, flashlight, first aid kit, survival blanket or warm blanket.
